Program admission requirements

- Be an internationally-trained Engineer or Technologist
- Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) 7 or above all skills (ESL Pathways, LINC or CLBPT), or
- ELA score of min 36 Reading, 13 essay, 20 Listening, 24 Speaking, or
- IELTS score: overall band 6.0 (no band lower than 5.5)

If you don't have a CLB language assessment:

Contact the VCC Assessment Centre (vcc.ca/assessments) to schedule the Canadian Language Benchmark Placement Test (CLBPT)
